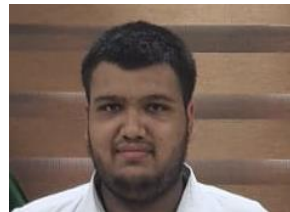

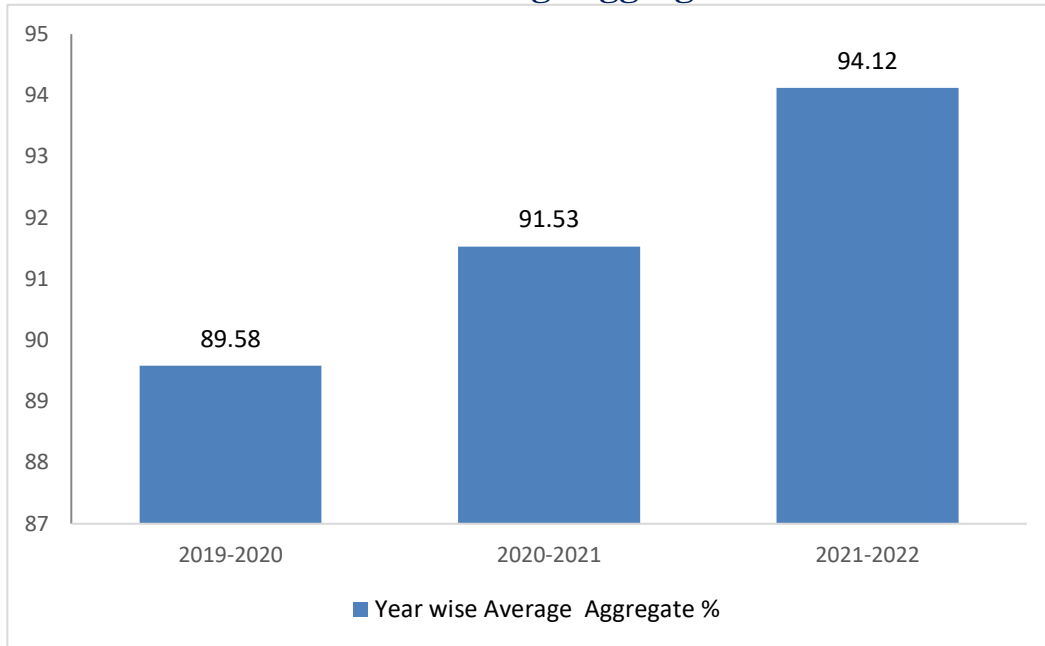

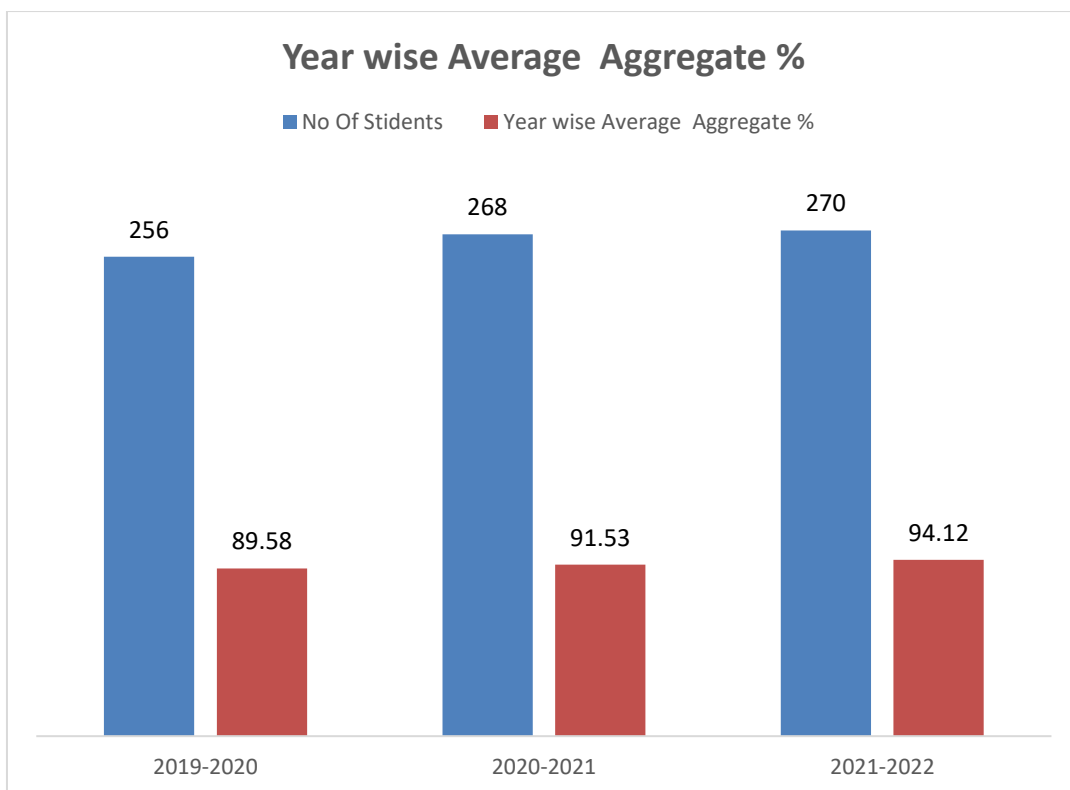

### Yearwise average aggregate %

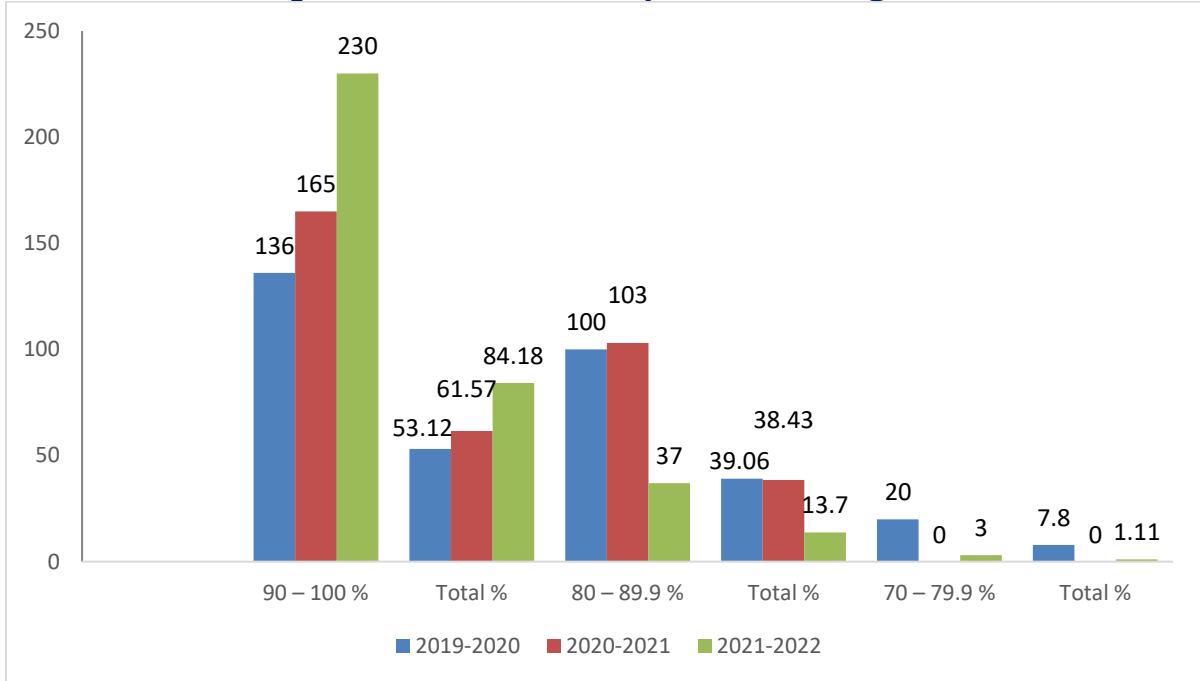


### Year wise Average Aggregate %

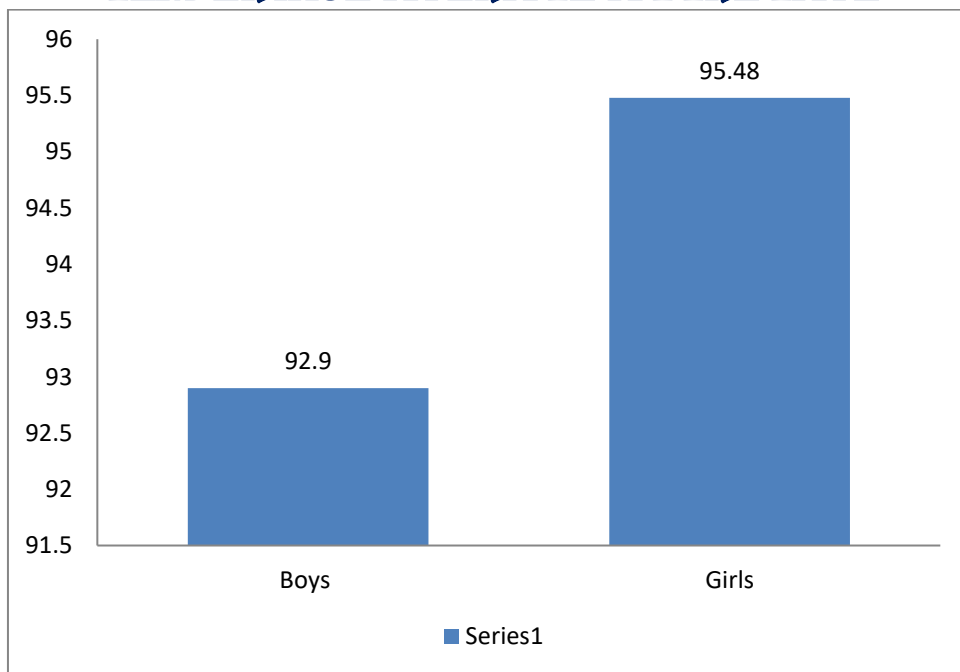

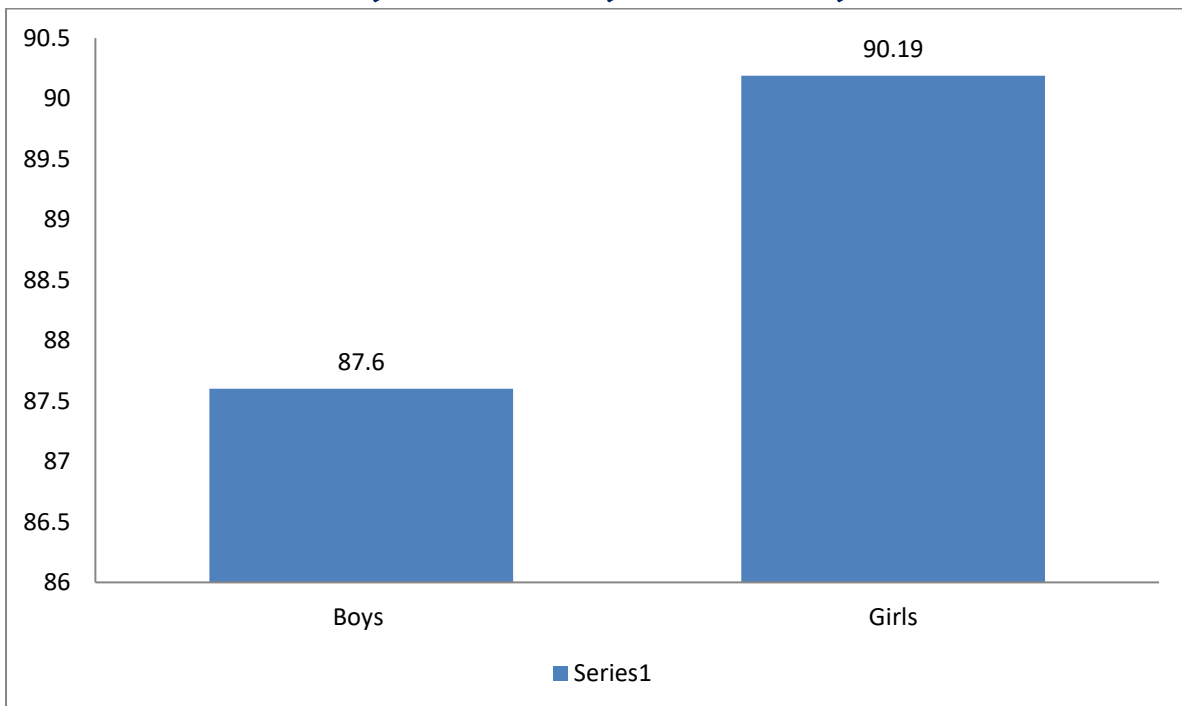


## AVERAGE AGGREGATE PERCENTAGE WISE

**Date : 29 July 2022**

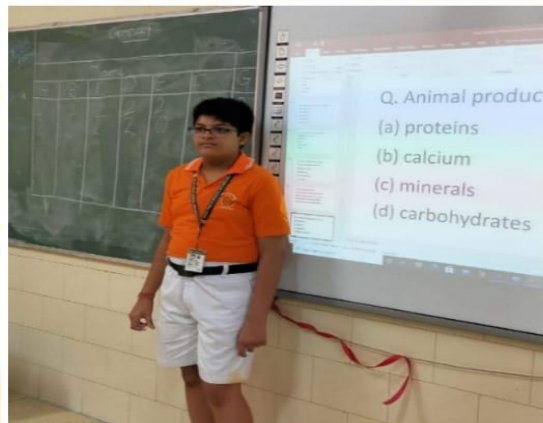

- ❖ **Workshop on Anger Management**  
**Date : 29 August 2022**

The key to anger is to learn how to manage it, like any other emotion so that it can be channelized into appropriate action.

Anger management skills help children to understand what is behind their anger, and how they can express it in a more healthy way. This will allow them to communicate their message more clearly. Aiming for the same objectives, Delhi Public School Bulandshahr conducted an Anger Management Session for the students of class V on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2022. Ms Sapna Sharma and Ms Ritu Singh were the resource people who mentored the students on how to overcome their anger.
