At COP27, Biden tightens methane emissions rule

Sharm el-Sheikh: Amid growing criticism from developing countries over the rich nations' failure to fulfil their financial pledges, US President Joe Biden on Friday landed at the UN climate conference (COP27) with a handful of new initiatives to show his

country's sincerity towards the climate crisis ahead of last week's crucial negotiations involving ministers during the high-level segment.

The initiatives announced by Biden include doubling the US pledge to the adaptation fund to \$100 million for global climate resilience, expanding access to its early warning system for African countries, and strengthening proposed domestic methane regulations in the oil and gas sector that would reduce the country's methane from covered sources by 87% below 2025 levels.

during paddy cultivation and from the ruminants of cattle. The GMP is not part of the official decisions under the UN framework, but it is considered an important global effort to cut methane emissions which have significantly higher warming potential. Experts noted that limiting warming to 1.5 degree C will require dramatic reductions in global methane emissions of at least 30% by 2030 from 2020 levels.

The GMP was launched by the US and European Union at COP26 in Glasgow last year. Currently, the oil and gas sector represents the fastest and deepest methane emissions reductions opportunities to achieve the GMP target.

"As Russia's unjust war in Ukraine disrupts energy markets, strains economies with rising prices, and threatens vulnerable countries with food shortages, efforts to accelerate climate action, climate smart agriculture, and global resilience have become all the more urgent," said the US government statement while issuing details of Biden's announcements.

India and France in deft clinch, in air & on sea

New Delhi: India and France are now set to undertake a joint maritime surveillance mission in the southern Indian Ocean Region (IOR) as part of their robust strategic partnership, even as their air force chiefs took to the skies in fighters during the ongoing 'Garuda' air combat exercise in Jodhpur on Tuesday. Officials said a P-8I long-range maritime patrol aircraft of the Indian Navy has touched down at the strategically-located La Réunion, a French overseas island east of Madagascar and southwest of Mauritius, for coordinated surveillance and ocean-mapping operations with the French Navy "to further enhance maritime domain awareness, security and safety in the southern IOR".

This comes important with China, which has the world's largest Navy with 355 warships and submarines, actively scouting for logistical facilities in the IOR after establishing its first overseas base at Djibouti on the Horn of Africa in 2017. Concurrently, in the ongoing seventh edition of the bilateral Garuda exercise at Jodhpur, Air Chief Marshal V R Chaudhary flew in a twin-seat Rafale jet, while French Air and Space Force (FASF) chief General Stéphane Mille undertook a sortie in a Sukhoi-30MKI on Tuesday.

There is growing interoperability between IAF and FASF with the Garuda exercise providing a "unique opportunity" for both to learn from each other and imbibe best practices during operations, ACM Chaudhary said. Stressing it was important to learn how to interoperate with friendly nations, the IAF chief said air power will play a very vital role in deciding the outcome of any future conflict.

Narender storms into SE, assures India's 12th medal

Boxer Narender added to India's glory at the Asian Boxing Championships after winning his quarterfinal match, assuring the country of its twelfth medal at the competition. In the men's +92kg event, Narender put up a dominant display to defeat Iman Ra-

nov of Kazakhstan, who won the silver medal at the 2018 Asian Games, defeated Sachin, who was fighting in the men's 71kg division, 4-1.

In contrast, Uzbekistan's Aslonov Odiljon blanked Lakshya 5-0 in the men's 80kg division. Naveen Kumar, competing in the men's 92kg division, was eliminated early after suffering a 5-0 defeat to Kazakhstan's Aibek Oralbay.

In the men's 75kg division, Sumit defeated Thailand's Sorwit Kamaduan 3-2 to secure a place in the semifinals. After losing their quarterfinal matches, the other three boxers competing on Monday were unable to advance to the last four. Aslanbek Shymberge-

Lovlina Borgohain (75 kg), bronze medalist in Tokyo Olympics, and Parveen (63 kg), bronze medalist at the Worlds, are two of the 7 Indian women boxers who will compete in their semis on Wednesday. Minakshi (52 kg), Preeti (57 kg), Ankushita Boro (66 kg), Saweety Boora (81 kg) and Alfiya (+81 kg) are the others. AGENCIES
