

By involving your child in the following skill based activities help your child to beindependent

SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL SKILLS

Good manners and Good habits are lifelong assets and they should be practiced until they become habit.

- Conversing freely and confidently with visitors and relatives.
- Greeting someone with a smile.
- Serving water and food to guests and family members.
- Answering the phone calls saying 'hello', and asking who is calling?
- Speaking politely.
- Sharing with friends.
- Taking turns.
- Using magical words like -I'm sorry, Please, Excuse me, Thank you, May I, Welcome.
- Let your child express his/her views freely but guide them how to express.

LINGUISTIC AND READING SKILLS

- Read a story at least twice a week. Discuss about its pictures, characters and moral related to the story.
- Commuting to different places with family is the best time to be spent together. Utilize this time fruitfully by discussing the things, your child visualises from the surroundings instead of engaging yourself or your child on electronic gadgets.

Help them converse small sentences like:

- Mummy, can I help you in the kitchen?
- Mummy, can I lay the table today?
- Mummy, should I help you wash the dishes today?
- Papa, can I help you wash the car?
- Grandpa, should I come with you for a walk?
- Grandma, should I help you put the thread in the needle?
- Mummy, can I get you a glass of water?
- Mummy, may I take some more Ice-cream from the fridge?
- Papa, please teach me how to ride a bicycle.
- Mummy, can I help you wash and soak the rice?
- Didi, can you help me find my English note book?

Wishing people properly - Hello Uncle / Aunty how are you? Wishing parents and elders Good Morning, Good Afternoon, Good Evening and Good Night. If we, as teachers and parents make a sincere effort and pay attention to the above mentioned points, we can help our children to learn, to understand and speak English at an early stage

WRITING SKILLS

Help your ward practice one page handwriting in English, Hindi. Use rough notebooks.

TECHNICAL SKILLS

- Help your ward to operate computer and also create awareness about different parts of computer and its uses.
- Holding of mouse. Clicking of left and right mouse button.
- Give them awareness of different gadgets.

AESTHETIC SKILLS

- Help your ward to follow the correct colouring strokes and creating imaginary drawings.

- Synthesize your child's knowledge by giving a scientific reason for the experiment done.
- Conduct any one simple experiment together. Make a video and share it with the class teacher.

LOGICAL REASONING & ANALYTICAL SKILLS

- Do not curb the curiosity of your child, give reasons for every query asked.
- Enhance your child's mental ability by giving them puzzles, sudoko's etc. from newspaper and magazines.

Help your child to take care of 'Personal Hygiene' by training them in thefollowing:-

- Brushing teeth twice daily.
- · Combing hair regularly.
- Bathing every day.
- Washing hands before and after meals.
- Trimming the nails and keeping them clean.
- Covering his or her nose and mouth when he/she coughs or sneezes.
- Avoid licking his/her finger while eating food.
- Avoid eating uncovered food.
- Avoid sharing towel, handkerchief, and brush with other people.
- Keeping his/her hair lice free.
- Avoid touching his/her eyes, nose, mouth, ears with dirty hands. Visit your Doctor regularly.
